This evening, we were notified of a positive COVID-19 case within our middle school. As indicated in our preparedness plan, we will close our campus for deep cleaning and to complete contact tracing. **Therefore, Crescent Academy International will be closed for in-person and online learners from Wednesday, November 11 through Friday, November 13.** More information will be sent soon regarding the date that learning will resume.

We are taking immediate action to report this information to the Wayne County Health Department (WCHD) and we will be cooperating with them to identify students or staff who may need to go into quarantine.

We remind you to remain vigilant and monitor yourself and your household for symptoms including fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.

If you or anyone in your household develops symptoms, we urge you to get tested for COVID-19. We also ask you to maintain open and prompt communication by continuing to fill out the daily VOLO application, which helps us assess the health of our community. Within the next 24 hours, you can expect to receive an email communication from Crescent that notifies you if your student was considered to be in close contact with the positive individual or not.

We will continue to be transparent in our communication as updated information becomes available.
